Timetable & Prices

The course will run in our Primary building from Friday 1st July to Thursday 28th July inclusive.

We begin in the morning at 9.00 a.m. and the children should be collected at 2.00 p.m. A mid-morning snack is served.

You can attend the Summer School for two weeks or the whole month, but let us know in advance, so the proper arrangements can be made.

The cost per child is 545 € for the entire month and includes all necessary materials (although a smock is recommend for art activities.) A two week course is 275 € and extra days are charged at 30 € per day.
